The St. Paul LWML is made up of three Circles (Clara, Eve & Members at Large) and Anna Circle (all Honorary), other Honorary members. Circles meet and have a Bible study, a business meeting, fellowship, and refreshments.

The purpose of St. Paul's LWML is to carry on a God-pleasing program of knowledge, service and charity; to assist the congregation in its undertakings; to support the missions and charitable institutions of our church in general, and the program of the LWML in particular; and to promote and cultivate Christian fellowship and to grow spiritually.

#### **NOTES FOR 2024**

<u>DEVOTIONS AND TOPIC FOR LWML</u>: Devotions will be led by the Circle that is responsible for refreshments as scheduled in the handbook. You are responsible for providing a pianist and distribution of hymnals if needed. Pastor Bertram will lead us in a Bible Study unless the designated Circle chooses to have a guest speaker for the assigned month. (Please contact Pastor in advance if you choose to have an outside guest speaker.)

<u>HOSTESSES</u>: The hostesses will consist of one Circle per meeting assigned. They decide what to serve and how much will be needed.

<u>LUTHERAN</u> <u>WOMEN'S</u> <u>MISSIONARY</u> <u>LEAGUE</u> <u>MITE</u> <u>BOX</u>: Contributions are to be turned in to the Mite Box Chairman, Kathy (Richard) Eyerly. Table collections at LWML meetings and our special December Mites Collection are included in Mite Box Offerings. There will be a door offering on LWML Sunday each year.

**DECEMBER CHRISTMAS GET-TOGETHER:** Refer to your December meeting page for more information on this. Plan ahead to bring a guest. Share the fellowship of our LWML with those women who are not members, and with relatives and friends. Executive Board will be in charge of the program.

#### **NOTES FOR 2024— CONTINUED**

**FUNERAL OF LWML MEMBER:** In the event that one of our members is called to her Eternal Home, LWML members can meet in the corridor twenty minutes prior to the funeral to sit as a group. There will be no further calling or announcement to this fact when and if someone dies. It will simply be the procedure followed for all current LWML members.

<u>DUES</u>: The dues of this society are to be turned in to the Treasurer of the St. Paul LWML from each Circle at the beginning of the year. Dues are \$12.00 a year. These dues are to be determined at the Fall Quarterly meeting (per Bylaw Article IX, Section 1). Zone dues (\$2.00) and the Equalization dues (\$5.50) are sent to the Blue Earth Zone LWML Treasurer. Total of \$19.50 should be paid to the treasurer. \$6.00 for *Quarterly* magazine is suggested. Members who have reached the age of 75 years may become honorary members of the society. The honorary member shall continue to pay dues, including zone dues and/or district's equalization. Society dues shall be optional. Honorary members do have a vote and can hold office in the society.

**KITCHEN & FELLOWSHIP ROOM CLEANING** is listed three (3) times a year. A list of duties is posted in the kitchen on the inside of the "cleaning supply" cupboard, to your left, as you enter the kitchen.

<u>CALLING</u>: Circles will call on shut-ins and those ill who are on the calling list on a monthly basis, organized by Pat Hall. New calling lists are issued in February, June and October.

#### ELECTED OFFICERS & COMMITTEES — Continued

**PRESIDENT:** The term of President is two years (on ballot in odd years). She presides at LWML and Executive Board meetings, brings all motions, appoints tellers for the ballot votes, and sees to it that all resolutions of the society are carried out. She is the contact person of Meals-on-Wheels for our church and appoints the St. Paul key lady for this community project. She attends the March LWML Zone Delegate Board meeting, bringing with her names of nominees for zone officers. She orders shut-in Christmas gifts (as head of Executive Board), along with the calling person, and strives to keep members of our LWML and the congregation in harmony and fellowship with one another. In the event of the death of an LWML member, she will notify the mortician regarding seating of LWML members.

<u>VICE-PRESIDENT</u>: The term of vice-president is two years (on ballot in even years). She carries out all responsibilities of the President during her absence and also attends the Executive Board meetings regularly. She will prepare the ballot for the November LWML meeting. She compiles the information for the St. Paul LWML handbook and makes sure it is printed and distributed. As Christian Growth Chairman she monitors Christian education within our LWML Society and as Servant Resources Manager shares new ideas for reaching new members for LWML. All appointed committee members no longer willing to serve should contact the Vice President by November 15th.

**SECRETARY:** The term of secretary is two years (on ballot in even years). She takes the minutes of the LWML meetings and the Executive Board meetings, types and duplicates them for all the Circles. She reads correspondence at the meetings, writes necessary letters for the Society, and any other secretarial duties not listed. She keeps all motions pertaining to the Bylaws up to date and attached to the Bylaws. She will notify the church secretary if the Campership program will continue each year, changing date on application and having a few copies made for the school and the church offices.

#### ELECTED OFFICERS & COMMITTEES — Continued

TREASURER: The term of the treasurer is two years (on ballot in odd years). She is responsible for collecting dues from the Circles. She collects all money and pays all bills attributed to the LWML and makes an annual report. She collects for the Blue Earth LWML Zone dues of \$2.00 (per member) and Equalization funds of \$5.00 (per member) annually to be sent to the Blue Earth LWML Zone Treasurer in December. (The amount due from each member is \$12.00 for the St. Paul LWML dues, \$2.00 for Blue Earth LWML Zone dues, \$5.50 for Equalization dues, making a total of \$19.50 that we pay to the St. Paul LWML Treasurer. Add \$6.00 to order the Quarterly, making it \$25.50 payable to the Treasurer.) She orders the Quarterly magazine by March 1st.

<u>WAYS & MEANS COMMITTEE</u>: This committee coordinates the planning for projects of the Society designated by the President and/or Executive Board and solicits necessary help for carrying out these projects. Its members are elected for a two-year term with three being elected each year. Senior members\* shall act as co-chairpersons in each respective year. One or two ladies will launder the towels after the Ham Supper.

<u>LUTHERAN</u> <u>WOMEN'S</u> <u>MISSIONARY</u> <u>LEAGUE</u> <u>ZONE</u> <u>DELEGATES</u>: The LWML zone delegates are elected for a two-year term with one person being elected each year. The duties of the LWML delegates are to attend the two Zone Delegate Board Meetings (August & March.) as the Society's voting delegates as well as the two Zone rallies. One shall serve as the public-relations person and the other as the historian. #### <u>APPOINTED COMMITTEES — CONTINUED</u>

<u>ALTAR GUILD</u>: The altar guild consists of members from each Circle, as well as other groups that are not members of LWML. These people are responsible for changing the altar linens, washing the altar cloths, dusting the chancel, polishing the brass, filling oil candles, setting up before and cleaning up after communion, placing flowers on the altar and removing them, washing confirmation robes after Confirmation.




